Tournament Rules and Regulations

Entry fee is \$10 and tournament tickets must be purchased NO LATER than 4 pm on Friday, May 21, 2010. **No tournament tickets will be sold after the tournament officially begins. Raffle tickets will continue to be sold until the drawing at 1:00 pm on Sunday, May 23, 2010.** Credit card purchases can be made by calling the St. Clair Boat Harbor at 810.329.4125.

Each day's Walleye entry must be caught and weighed-in during tournament hours:

- Day 1: Friday, May 21, 2010, 4:00 pm to 12:00 Midnight (weigh-in starts at 5:00 p.m.)
- Day 2: Saturday, May 22, 2010, 12:01 am to 12:00 Midnight
- Day 3: Sunday, May 23, 2010, 12:01 am to 12:00 Noon

Walleye entry submitted for weigh-in must be ALIVE and deemed to be in "fresh-like" condition; as agreed by tournament judges. The tournament boundary is the St Clair River.

Entries must be accompanied by both (a) ticket stub and (b) photo identification.

Each day's winner will be determined by the heaviest weight. In the event of a tie, the winning walleye entry will be the FIRST FISH brought in to be weighed and entered.

No alcohol is to be consumed at weigh-in station. Tournament fishermen MUST COMPLY with Michigan & U.S. Rules and Regulations, and U.S. Coast Guard safety requirements. Participants are responsible for any damage to the boats they use or caused to the boats, property, or persons or other, and for any insurance desired.

Registrants must be willing to make a sworn statement that their fish was caught within the rules of the contest. A polygraph test may be requested if contest officials deem necessary. Refusal will be grounds for disqualification.

All walleyes may be registered only once and will be marked at the weigh-in station.

All "Top-Five" walleye caught each day will be retained for display during the time of the tournament. Fish will be returned after tournament ends. It is the responsibility of the angler to pick up his/her fish by 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 23, 2010.

Heaviest walleye of the tournament-THE HOG- will be announced during the Awards Ceremony held noon Sunday May 23, 2010.

Walleye entered in the Adult Tournament cannot be entered in the Kid's Tournament.

Income and other taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the winners.

St. Clair River Marbleye Classic Inc. and its sponsors may publish photographs of the Event and participants names, likeness of the participant and photograph for advertising, editorial, and/or publicity purposes. Kids photos will not be used without the written consent of a parent or guardian.

Protests must be filed by 12:15 p.m. on Sunday, May 23, 2010 with the Tournament Committee. A \$100.00 protest fee will be charged for any protest filed. If the protest is up-held the \$100.00 will be refunded.

If participant violates any tournament rules or if it has been determined by the Tournament Committee that the participant has been disqualified from other tournaments for rules violations, they may be disqualified.

All rules have "loop holes". It is the intention for the Tournament Committee to provide a sportsman like tournament. All questions or problems are to be referred to the Tournament Committee. They have sole jurisdiction in determining the application of the rules.

WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS: All contestants in submitting a raffle/entry ticket agree to hold harmless the: City of St. Clair and its employees, St. Clair Boat Harbor and its employees, St. Clair River Marbleye Classic Inc. and its committee members, any and all promoters, sponsors, tournament directors, members, agents, volunteers and organizations assisting St. Clair River Marbleye Classic Inc. in operation of the tournament. Furthermore, all contestants agree to waive all responsibility for death, injuries, damage, liability, theft, fire, or loss of any kind to entrants.
